

Training for NEW Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, & Altar Servers

To be a **Eucharistic Minister** and distribute the Body and Blood of Christ in Mass, you must be Confirmed and at least 16*.

Are you a good public speaker, Confirmed, and at least 16*? The **two-part training** for new **Lectors** offers two choices for the initial meeting as well as the follow-up (NOTE: this is for all Masses **except 10am** – there is separate training for the Children’s Liturgy.).

Boys and girls can be an **Altar Server**. *The training at this time is open to students 5th Grade and older and 4th Graders who will be serving at all Masses EXCEPT 10am.* (Because the 10am Mass has so many Servers, training for 4th Graders for that Mass will be in early 2020 -- watch the bulletin and website for more information.)

You and an adult must attend an orientation meeting in the church. You will return to be tested.

Training sessions for all these ministries take place **in the church**. You need **only attend one of the options** from below:

SERVERS: Saturday, Sept. 21 – 1pm **OR** Monday, Sept. 23 – 3pm OR 4pm

EMs: Tuesday, Oct. 1 – 6pm **OR** Saturday, October 5 – 10:30am

LECTORS: Tuesday, Oct. 1 – 7pm **OR** Saturday, October 6 – 11:30am

All ministers must be registered St. Viator parishioners.

***NOTE:** All St. Viator ministers out of high school must be in compliance with the diocesan volunteer requirements: be fingerprinted (if 18 or older), submit a volunteer application, review the volunteer handbook, and take an online class. Please see “Volunteer Requirements” at stviator.org
