

Principal Eucharistic Minister (1C)

BEFORE MASS

See how many ciboria are in the tabernacle. Prepare as many additional that are needed for a total of seven. For the new ones, put half a sleeve of wafers in each (about 50).

Put out items on the credence table - a checklist there will help you.

Always set out the same chalice (we will have a photo of it in the rear sacristy). If a Presider wants a different one, he will exchange it.

Set the gift table: large host on paten and cruet filled with wine

DURING MASS

After the Intentions, set the altar, following the cheat sheet (included here). Bring the items to the altar. If Deacon Mike is assisting, he will take them from you.

As soon as the “Lamb of God” begins, bring ciboria from the tabernacle to the altar – recruit someone to help you if there are more than two.

AFTER MASS

Do not clean the chalice – Father will do that.

If there are crumbs in a ciborium:

put them in the chalice

OR

run some water through the ciborium . . . pour the water into the sink on the right . . . dry with a paper towel

Set out ciboria for the next Mass Noon.

Put the tabernacle key in the sprinkling bowl, along with the key to the safe.

Credence Table

When the announcement for the collection begins, take the book, the chalice, and the bowls of bread to the altar. (The bowls go on the **left side**, the book and chalice in the center.)

THEN . . .

The gifts are brought up.

THEN . . .

Wait at Father's chair with the small water. When Father turns to you, bring it to him, with the handle facing him. He may also give you the small wine to return to the table.

THEN . . .

Wait at Father's chair with the large pitcher, the bowl, and the towel. When Father turns to you, go and wash his hands.
