



Dear San Viator Family,

These past weeks, since I joyfully began my ministry as pastor of this beloved parish, have been filled with grace—new faces, warm welcomes, and moments of prayer that reflect the great faith and love present in this community.

I've had the opportunity to meet with the Parish Council, the Finance Committee, and the parish staff. In each conversation, I've sensed deep commitment and a sincere love for the Church. I'm truly grateful for the openness and the spirit of service I have encountered. I believe the Holy Spirit is gently guiding us, and I look forward to walking this journey of faith with all of you.



Today, I want to extend a special invitation—something that is close to my heart. Let us begin, as a parish, our First Friday Eucharistic Adoration, starting on Friday, August 1st:

- After the 8:15 a.m. Mass, we will have two hours of silent adoration in the chapel, until 11:00 a.m.
- In the evening, we will gather in the church from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. for a Holy Hour of Adoration.

It will be a sacred time to come before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and bring Him our prayers—for ourselves, for the Church, and for the world. Jesus in the Eucharist is the heart of our faith, the center of our lives, and the source of our hope. He is truly present, waiting for us with love, ready to listen, strengthen, and console us. In silent adoration, we rest in His presence.

I also want to remind you of the importance of our Sunday Eucharist—that special moment when we come together as brothers and sisters in Christ. Let us not stop celebrating the Eucharist every Sunday. Let us not stop participating, receiving Jesus, and welcoming the blessings He offers. I look forward to seeing you at our Sunday Masses, where the Lord gathers us, nourishes us, and sends us forth to share His love.

Let us grow in love for Jesus in the Eucharist. May we be a parish that keeps Christ at the center—especially Christ present in the Eucharist. As two beloved saints remind us:

"There is nothing so great as the Eucharist... If we really understood it, we would die of love." — St. John Mary Vianney

St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) was born Margaret Alacoque in a small village in France. After her father died when she was eight years old, she was sent to a convent school run by the Poor Clares became bedridden where she rheumatic fever. For four years she was confined to her bed until she made a vow to Mary, Mother of God, to consecrate herself to religious life. Following this vow, her health was restored. Throughout her childhood and early adulthood, Margaret continued to have religious visions of Jesus.

In 1671, at age 24, Margaret entered the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary and took the name Mary when she professed her vows. During her time in the convent, she had a series of mystical experiences most notably, her encounters with the Sacred Heart of Jesus. According to her accounts, Jesus appeared to her and revealed his Sacred Heart, burning with love for humanity and instructed her to devote herself to adoration of the Eucharist every Thursday night during a holy hour which she immediately incorporated into her routine. He also instructed her to celebrate a new feast, the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

St. Margaret Mary dedicated herself to promoting the feast and adoration of the Eucharist. Her visions and messages were met with skepticism initially, but she trusted God's guidance. In 1688, just two years before she died, the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was celebrated for the first time in the Church's liturgical calendar. Eventually, her holy hour of adoration also became a popular tradition among Catholics worldwide.





# Classes for Youth Confirmation



### What happens at Confirmation?

St. Viator Confirmation program is a two year program that includes large group ice breakers, guest speakers, and small groups that take part in faith discussions, world issues, styles of prayer, and how to live out the gifts of the Holy Spirit.



# YEAR 1 & 2 Program

The Year 1 program runs from September through April.
Classes begin on Sundays from 3-4:45pm in the Parish Center.
Students will complete classes, ministry nights, and small group projects in order to complete year 1 confirmation.

The Year 2 program runs from October through April. Classes are on Sundays in the Parish Center from 2-6pm which includes the 5pm mass Students will complete large group sessions, youth groups, and community service hours in order to be confirmed.

Year 1 & 2 detailed calendars will be distributed and reviewed during Orientation.
